Due to the overwhelming number of entries that the parade has had in current years, entries will be held to 170 entries only., on a first come, first serve bases.

A final information packet will be mailed to each entry within 7 business days after the August 14, deadline. It will include your Parade Participant Pass, Parade Route, and Special Units instructions, along with additional information regarding check-in procedures, directions for registration, and staging areas. It is imperative that you bring your Parade Participant Pass with you the morning of the parade. Only those with the passes will be allowed in the staging areas by Parade Security.
